Twenty years ago the name PIPA did not even exist. There was already a website about pigeon racing but the PIPA domain name was not registered until 16th of December 2000. We could say that the publication of this catalogue marks the twentieth birthday of PIPA. Twenty years is a long time, even though I still feel young. And in a way it does not feel that long at all, because it went by so fast. We have grown a lot and we developed very quickly. And the best part is that PIPA was never intended to develop into a company; it was rooted in a passion for pigeon racing.

> I have been passionate about pigeon racing from a young age. For instance, I witnessed the arrival of the 1995 1st International Barcelona of my grandfather Remi. I was 15 at the time and did not yet fully appreciate what had just happened. It was not until many years later, and to this day, that I began to understand the true impact started developing a website that would serve as an information platform for fanciers from across the globe. At the time, I had no intention pigeons only came up when I had to decide between looking for a job or continuing the PIPA project. I graduated in 2003 and I knew

of this achievement. In any case, this victory from Barcelona clearly boosted my interest in pigeon racing. The following year I eagerly to make money out of it. The idea of creating an auction house for I had to try and generate money from PIPA, I asked my father Carlo if he happened to have a pigeon for sale, and that one pigeon led to several others. I am very grateful that my grandfather took that important victory. Laureaat Barcelona, which my father had bred, was a fabulous looking racing bird. I have always had the utmost respect for what my father and grandfather achieved in pigeon racing and beyond. Meanwhile, my father and mother have always been very supportive towards me and my brother.

For instance, I had my first computer at a very young age and we had an internet connection very early on as well. My family has always been there for me. used to study at my grandfather's home because it was very quiet there, with few distractions. He motivated me, just like he used to motivate his own kids. My brother

has been very important to me as well. He would back me up at PIPA any time I was going through a difficult time, and I am still very grateful for that. He continued his involvement with PIPA and he contributed a lot to the further development of the project. In all honesty, I never would have made it this far without the help of my family. And chances are, PIPA would not even exist if my family had not been rooted in pigeon racing. I would like to send a sincere thank you to all of you. My wife has been

very supportive over the years as well, even though I was often away from home and we could not spend a lot of time together.

Twenty years of hard work, twenty years of commitment day and night. It has paid off. My father, my brother, myself, close friends like Martin Degrave and the many employees and agents - together we have turned PIPA into what it is today: the most exclusive auction house for pigeons worldwide! And

> I am very proud of it. This "child" from back in the day has become an "adolescent", and our adolescent is doing just fine.

Entrepreneurship is something had to familiarize myself with over the years. It is an art that has to be developed in small steps. You have to progressively gain an insight into a variety of processes in

order to try and get a grip on your company. Making decisions in everyone's interest and in the interest of the company is vitally important, in the short term but particularly in the long term. I honestly think that this sets me apart from most other entrepreneurs: I would never choose to pursue shortterm success if it could potentially harm PIPA's interests in the long term. We often make decisions that might not have an immediate impact but that will prove beneficial in the long term.


